In 1989, Robert founded Community Options, Inc. around his small kitchen table in Bordentown, New Jersey. Today, Community Options operates in 37 cities across 10 states supporting thousands of people with disabilities and their families with the help of over 2,500 employees.

Robert Stack has dedicated his entire life to supporting people with disabilities. It is through this passion that he founded Community Options in 1989. He started this non-profit with \$50,000 in New Jersey and grew it into a thirty-seven city, ten state operation with over 2,500 employees and an annual budget of almost \$100 million. Over the past five years, Robert has been steadily writing opinion editorials related to government, current affairs and business, which have been featured in outlets such as The Washington Times, The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and The Dallas Morning News.

Robert is a disability and nonprofit expert and specializes in human resources, fiscal operations, development, quality assurance, fundraising and mission adherence. He has an MBA and a BA from the University Of Dayton and is currently an adjunct professor at Kean University.
