"For over twenty years, I have learned and developed strategies to support those who serve people with disabilities through my commitment to quality, cost-effective administration and leadership. Abraham currently serves on the State Medicaid Managed Care Advisory Committee, a position she's held since 2014.

Abraham graduated with an Associate's Degree in Psychology from Navarro College in 1997 and earned her BAAS in Business Management and Marketing from Texas A&M University in 2011.
