Community Options to Open New Office in King of Prussia

PRINCETON, NJ -- On Tuesday, June 27, 2017 at 12 p.m., Community Options will hold a ribbon cutting ceremony for its newest office in King of Prussia. Greg Phillips, Vice Chair of Board of Supervisors in Upper Merion township will be in attendance, and a luncheon is scheduled to follow the ceremony.

"The new office will provide a dedicated training and development space for direct care staff, enrichment space for our individuals and a modern and organized location for office staff to continue to provide quality day to day services for the individuals we support," said Leslie Healy, Community Options' Executive Director of Montgomery, Delaware and Chester counties in Pennsylvania. "We look forward to having a new and professional office space to continue with current operations, as well as the opportunity for future development and growth in our region."

Community Options purchased the building in early April and will officially move into the building on July 6, serving as Community Options' King of Prussia office operations. The office currently supports 22 individuals that live in the community. Community Options also operates in Montgomery, Chester, Delaware and Philadelphia counties, where 15 office staffers oversee 14 homes, as well as 110 direct care staff.
