This year the race in Bridgewater will be held at Duke Island Park. All funds raised will be utilized to support people with disabilities in the Somerset County, New Jersey region. The race in Bridgewater will be one of 31 Cupid's Chase races taking place on February 8<sup>th</sup> across 9 states. Last year, Community Options netted over \$100,000 with 6,000 runners in attendance across the country.

Each runner will receive a shirt that says "Available" or "Unavailable" in spirit of the Valentine's Day theme.
